Conduct or Players/Family/Friends: PITBULL Baseball Organization welcomes family and friends of the children in the program to come to the field to encourage the children. In return, the PITBULL Baseball Organization expects the children, as well as the family members and friends attending the games, practices, and clinics to conduct themselves properly. Proper conduct includes treating the players, coaches and umpires with respect and rooting for your child and not against other children. Improper behavior includes arguing/berating the umpires /coaches and using abusive and foul language. The Directors of PITBULL Baseball Organization will have a ZERO tolerance policy regarding poor conduct. The Directors reserve the right to suspend or expel a PLAYER in the program if her/his conduct or the conduct of any of her/his family or friends attending the game are deemed inappropriate by the Directors and are subject to removal from the Field complex/Practice facility. Only PITBULL Baseball Organization approved and trained coaches are permitted on the field and in the dugouts. All parents and siblings must stay outside the filed/dugout area and should sit outside the field of play.
